2025 Event Highlights

GMU High School Summer Camp

We were proud to once again participate in GMU's annual summer camp. This event provides the opportunity to nurture the next generation through engaging workshops, poster sessions, and presentations. This year HIE-VA was able to award two outstanding students with \$2,000 in scholarships and continued mentorship with some HIE-VA members.



Pathways to Science

We were proud to partner with the Pathway to Science program this year to assist in delivering a unique STEM experience to underrepresented youth. Participants constructed miniature houses with solar panels and LED lights to demonstrate the practical uses of renewable energy. The event also highlighted guest speakers and a dynamic Women in STEM panel discussion. HIE-VA awarded two laptops to high school Latina girls as part of our commitment to supporting future STEM leaders.



STEM Day Initiative

Our volunteers hosted a STEM workshop at a school participating in *Pasaporte a la Educación*. The volunteers guided around 40 students through model circuits to receive hands-on experience with power generation and delivery. Two lucky students were raffled model circuit boards so that they may continue to explore the fun of STEM at home. The remaining ten circuit boards were donated to the school so that the students may continue to experiment.

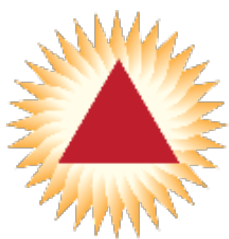
